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1.	Manage a COVID-19 case at the workplace	There are no mandatory requirements for staff or patrons who become COVID-19 cases. In Green season, the lodge is unsupervised. Patrons are responsible for their own care. However in an emergency they can contact the manager or committee member to seek assistance. In White Season, patrons are responsible for their own care. However, they can request assistance from the manager if they are too ill to cope alone. - Patron is a COVID-19 case Lodge rules, posted in all bedrooms, state: Sickness Colds, flu and viruses spread very quickly in a lodge environment. If you or a member of your family are ill, please consider the well-being of your fellow guests and restrict your movements in common areas such as the kitchen and dining areas. These considerations will apply to COVID-19. - Manager or family is a COVID-19 case They should minimise contact with patrons and wear masks where this is difficult to avoid.
2.	Address record keeping requirements, including the process for recording vaccination status of workers, if applicable to their sector	There are no mandatory requirements for COVID-19 related record keeping. No special information will be collected or kept.

3.	Address relevant face mask and protective personal equipment requirements	There are no mandatory requirements for masks or COVID-19 related PPE. A small supply of masks will be available in the laundry which patrons can access. Manager will also maintain a supply of masks for use by themselves and family
4.	Take steps to mitigate the introduction of COVID-19 to the workplace	Other than requesting that sick patrons be considerate to other guests (Item 1 above) there are no steps that can be taken to prevent COVID-19 entering the workplace. Other steps to mitigate COVID-19 spreading in the lodge • Patrons are required to clean up after themselves in common areas • Encourage patrons to use doors, windows and fans to improve ventilation • Patrons may request a RAT kit from the manager
5.	Respond to any symptomatic worker or confirmed cases of COVID-19	See item 1. above
6.	Document evidence of compliance with the COVIDSafe Plan.	There are no mandatory requirements for COVID-19 at the lodge. No measures for demonstrating compliance are required
7.	Ongoing	Monitor changes to government regulations regarding COVID-19 and update this plan as necessary
